With the latest firmware for the BERNINA 7- series following issues have been optimized:


Initial situation

Update of the release firmware on Version 32.43.10 B 780:



B 710/750QE:





- Unexpected machine stop
 The machine stop in sewing and embroidery mode has been corrected.
- 2.) Thread tension for stitches 1+2
 The thread tension for the straight and zig-zag stitch (stitches 1+2) has been optimized.

NEW

- 3.) A "sidestep" has been integrated in the thread cutter which is activated automatically after having completed the sewing function. The thread cutter performs a sideways step (below 1.0mm) to the left to avoid a thread cluster on the wrong side of the fabric.
- 4.) Flickering screens at B710 or B750 in case of flickering displays, the new firm ware helps. The clock rate has been increased to control the LCD-tolerances.

Service Program

The service program has been corrected and therefore improved in many issues. Nevertheless there are some deficiencies left which are still worked on.

- 5.) **4e:** The text hasn't been implemented yet, but the appearing number combination 1 1 has to be rated as "Mode ok".
- 6.) **6h:** After the presser foot height has been calibrated successfully, the red X-button has to be pressed to confirm:

 We do apologise for this error which is being revised. More information will follow.
- **7.) 6j**: For the time being the calibrating thread DMC Nr. 50 is the only one available as compensation values for other threads do not exist yet.
