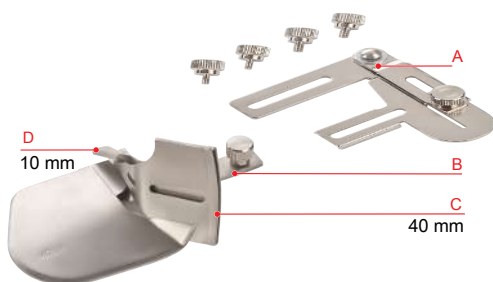


# Single Fold Binder Attachment

## Information

### Purpose

- For binding fabric edges with unfolded bias or jersey tapes of 40 mm width.

### For your safety

Before using this accessory, please read the instruction manual at hand as well as the instruction manual of your machine carefully.

### Overview

- A Accessory holder (not included in the scope of delivery)
- B Connecting piece with locking screw
- C Tape guide (40 mm)
- D Tape outlet channel (10 mm)

### How to prepare the Binder Attachment

- > Select the stitch. (Coverstitches No. 21, 22, 23 / Chainstitches No. 16 with LC)
- > Thread the machine.
- > Attach the presser foot. (#C13 for Coverstitch and Chainstitch)
- > Attach the Binder Attachment with accessory holder to the machine. Refer to the instruction manual of the accessory holder.
- > Loosen the locking screw of the connecting piece, position the Binding Attachment in front of the left coverstitch needle (LC) and tighten the screw again.
- > Loosen the locking screw on the swivel arm, position the Binder Attachment as close as possible to the presser foot tip and tighten the screw again.
  - The Binder Attachment and the presser foot are close to each other without direct contact.

### Sewing on the bias tape

- > Cut the end of the tape into a point. (Fig. 2)
- > Swinging out the Binder Attachment.
- > Push the tape tip through the tape guide until the tape comes out folded approx. 3 cm at the tape outlet channel. (Fig. 3)
- > Bring the Binder Attachment into sewing position and lower the presser foot onto the tape.
- > Sew a few stitches to fix the tape. (Fig. 4)

- > Check the seam position of the binding and, if necessary, adjust the position of the Binder Attachment by adjusting the locking screw on the connecting piece.
  - Sew on the tape close to the tape edge.
- > Push the edge of the fabric firmly to the right into the Binder Attachment and continue sewing. (Fig. 5)
  - The fabric edge lies in the tape fold.
- > Cut back any excess seam allowance on the wrong side of the fabric.
