

Adjustable Stippling Foot

Information

Purpose

- For free-motion quilting and embroidering.
- To quilt small designs and for detail work.

For your safety

Before using this accessory, please read the instruction manual at hand as well as the instruction manual of your machine carefully.



Application

Using the Stippling foot

- > Lower the feed dog.
- > Attach the slide-on table.
- > Attach the presser foot.
- > Select the Straight stitch No. 1.
- > If possible, minimize up and down movements of the presser foot. To do this, set the presser foot pressure to 0 or lower on the machine.
- > Select the «Needle stop down».
- > Place the fabric under the presser foot.
- > Lower the presser foot.
- > Adjust the height of the presser foot. To do this, turn the adjusting wheel of the presser foot until the fabric can be moved back and forth under the presser foot sole without difficulty. (Fig. 1)
- > Thread the needle.
- > Bring the bobbin thread up to the right side of the fabric.
- > Start sewing at slow speed. Move the fabric with your hands according to the sewing speed in order to achieve an even stitch length. (Fig. 2)

Tips

- > With the Q Series, select the quilting mode «BSR1» or «MAN».
- > If skipped stitches occur, reduce the presser foot height or the sewing speed.
- > For an optimal sewing result, use the Straight stitch plate.
- > For a beautiful stitch formation, use the same thread quality and color as upper and bobbin thread.
