Lesson Descriptions (Months 1-6)

Month 1

Project Month 1: Composition Notebook Cover

Keep your notes and thoughts organized in a personalized notebook cover! This quick project includes pockets and a pen holder for writing and storage on the go. It utilizes simple patchwork and finishing skills.

Embroidery Month 1: In the Hoop Plus

Learn how you can add an embroidery design to an existing in-the-hoop project, thanks to BERNINA's Plus embroidery features. Use ungrouping and embroidery sequence control to quickly insert a design at the right point in your embroidery. Easy, simple and fast!

Technique Month 1: Foot Feature - Ruffler Foot #86

Learn how to effectively use the BERNINA Ruffler Foot #86 to create the most beautiful pleats or ruffles for any project. This is a technique class that focuses on three settings on the foot, which will fine tune the ruffles to your preferences, easy and fast!

Month 2

Project Month 2: The Quick Corky Wallet

Try your hand at sewing cork with a simple and quick envelope-style wallet! This easy project makes for great gifts and showcases the utility of BERNINA non-stick sole presser feet. Uses Brewer pattern SASSLN0062

Embroidery Month 2: Lettering with Your Machine – Quilt Label

No quilt is finished until you label it! Learn to use your machine's built-in lettering to create an embroidered label with an added embroidery design for a completely customized look!

Technique Month 2: Free-Motion Quilting - Quilting Fillers

Learn the basics of free-motion guilting, how to get started, as well as a few practice tips and tricks. Learn beginning free-motion skills practicing simple wavy lines. Turn those wavy lines into basic fillers such as meandering, pebbles and swirly paisleys. This project will give you ample opportunity to practice your skills.

Month 3

Project Month 3: Wacky T-shirt Throw

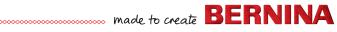
This Wacky T-shirt throw will go together easy and fast. Cut the focal point from your T-shirt and add strips to the sides and top and bottom to make it a 14 inch square. Stitch 20 together to make a 48 by 64 inch top and then quilt as you desire!

Embroidery Month 3: Pinpoint Placement

Pinpoint Placement is so easy even when your project not hooped perfectly. Learn how to simply select two points to determine the embroidery axis and size, check it to your liking and experience stitching success!

Technique Month 3: Overlock - A Balanced Stitch

Successful serging begins with understanding the stitch. Learn to dissect the components of 4-thread Overlock stitch formation. Then work to troubleshoot a balanced stitch and gain the confidence to adjust settings for all your textile and creative needs.





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Month 4

Project Month 4: Fast Fun Placemats

These fast and fun placemats are made with Soft and Stable by Annie and 2.5 inch wide strips of fabric. The ever popular flip and sew method will make fast work of these placemats. You will want to make a set for every season or occasion.

Embroidery Month 4: Free-arm Embroidery

Learn to use the BERNINA embroidery machine's free-arm, which provides you with more space when embroidering projects that are not flat. It makes it easier to create great looking embroidery even on a project with "shape" and can be used with several BERNINA hoop sizes.

Technique Month 4: Foot Feature – Invisible Zipper Foot #35

Learn how easy it is to add an invisible zipper to any project. Using the Invisible Zipper Foot #35 and a straight stitch, we will create a small bag, showing you how to quickly add that professional look of an invisible zipper!

Month 5

Project Month 5: Modern Heart Wall Handing

Make this sweet scrappy heart wall hanging with a modern twist. Learn Applique, embellishment with decorative stitching and stitch designer. This project is beginner friendly! Uses Brewer Pattern: RCQC535

Project Month 6: Take-Along Pouch

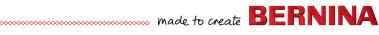
