

Skirt "Susan"

Modell 220-12
Sizes 36-48



PRINT THE CUT

1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter) (do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!)
2. Check the square – if it is 10x10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size (the overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet). **Important:** Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated.

SUPPLIES

- 2.2 m silk crepe satin, 140 cm wide
- Fabric lining G 710 (Vlieseline)
- Edging tape
- 1 seam-concealing (invisible) zip, 22 cm long
- 1 presser, 7 mm in diameter

CUTTING

- 1 1 × front skirt part on the fold
- 2 2 × back skirt part
- 3 2 × waistband on the fold

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Iron the fabric lining on the waistband and the edging tape on the seam allowance of the zip and let them cool off thoroughly.
2. Insert the Invisible zipper foot for seam-concealing zips. Pin one side of the zip tape right side on right side along the rear centre seam and sew from top down to the marking. Pin the second side in the same way and sew it in. Close the seam below the zip. Iron the allowances apart.
3. Fold the box pleats along the upper edges of the front and the back skirt according to the markings, pin them and sew them on the seam allowance.
4. Cut off the lower flap on the right side of the waistband. Sew the upper edge of the waistband and the narrow edges including the lower flap and turn it over. Cut back the allowances and iron the waistband. Sew the outer waistband right side on right side along the upper edge of the skirt. Topstitch the inner waistband in the seam shadow from the right.
5. Sew the presser to the upper edge of the lower flap and the waistband. Hem the skirt.
