
Pendant "Candy cane" Model 320-34 Height 12 cm





PRINT THE CUT

- 1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!)
- 2. Check the square if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
- 3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
- 4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

Important: Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated!

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Draw the candy cane mirror-inverted on Vliesofix. Iron the Vliesofix on the wrong side of the striped fabric and cut it out. Remove the backing paper and iron the appliqué part on the handicraft felt. Cut out the cane.
- 2. Stick Wonder Tape along the edge on the wrong side. Stick on the rickrack so that the centre runs roughly along the outer edge. Lay the ends on top of each other towards the inside.
- 3. Make a loop with the hanger yarn and knot it a few times. Place the hanger in the centre of the upper edge (the knots are on the part). Fix it with some Wonder Tape. Stick the candy canes on top of each other and narrow-topstitch them all around. Wrap the ribbon as a how

SUPPLIES

- Remnants of handicraft felt, felt 4 mm and striped fabric
- Striped rickrack and rep ribbon
- Vliesofix and Wonder Tape
- Hanger yarn

OPTIONAL BERNINA ACCESSORIES

• Reverse Pattern Foot with Clear Sole #34

CUTTING

1 × candy cane from 4-mm felt and handicraft felt, cut without allowances.








Pendant "Cinnamon Model 320-35 Diameter approx. 10 cm





PRINT THE CUT

- 1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!)
- 2. Check the square if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
- 3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
- 4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

Important: Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated!

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw the star outline on the felt and mark the centre point. Attach the circular embroidery attachment to the machine and place the centre point on the pin. Sew a decorative stitch. Cut out the outline of the star. Underlay the star tips with stabiliser and sew triangular decorative stitches. Draw a circle in the centre and cut it out. Use a hand sewing needle to attach the yarn for the hanger to a star tip and knot it.


- Remnants of felt 4 mm
- · Tear-away stabiliser
- Hanger yarn








Pendant "Lolly & Pastry" Model 320-36 Diameter 8 cm





PRINT THE CUT

- 1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!)
- 2. Check the square if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
- 3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
- 4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

Important: Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated!

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Draw the swirl resp. the flower mirror-inverted on Vliesofix. Iron the Vliesofix on the handicraft felt and cut them out. Remove the backing paper and iron the parts on the circles. Sew the parts on with the straight stitch. Underlay the flower shape with stabiliser and decorate it with decorative stitches and gemstones.
- 2. Add the hanger varn in the same way as with the candy cane. Place the circle wrong side on wrong side, pad them with decorative cotton wool and fix the layers. Narrow-topstitch the layers with the straight stitch or the blanket stitch.

SUPPLIES

- Remnants of handicraft felt
- Decorative cotton wool
- Vliesofix, tear-away stabiliser
- Wonder Tape, hanger yarn

CUTTING

2 x a circle each, 8 cm in diameter, cut here without allowances.








Pendant "Drop" Model 320-37 Size 8.5×11 cm





PRINT THE CUT

- 1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!)
- 2. Check the square if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
- 3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
- 4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

Important: Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated!

SUPPLIES

• Like model 320-36

CUTTING

2 × drop, cut without allowance

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Finish the drop like model 320-36, but use the zigzag stitch to sew the layers together.

PRINT THE CUT

- 1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!)
- 2. Check the square if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
- 3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
- 4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Iron the long edges of the decorative fabric to the back. Place the bag on the fold mark of the lower edge. Align the decorative fabric along the lower edge and sew on the long sides narrow-edged.
- 2. Numbers: Select the desired font and size on your computer and print out the numbers or numerals. Attach the parts with Vliesofix as described for the candy cane.
- 3. Trim the upper edges of the bag with the pinking scissors. Place the bag right side on right side on the fold and close the sides. Trim the seam allowances with the pinking scissors. Turn the bag over.

SUPPLIES FOR 2 BAGS

- 0.2 m cotton fabric, 140 cm wide
- Remnants of patterned fabrics
- Handicraft felt and remnants of Vliesofix
- Cord or tape for tying up
- Pinking scissors

Bag 17×56 cm, if wanted, decorative fabric 17×10 cm







Kitchen towels Model 320-39 Size 50×70 cm





PRINT THE CUT

- 1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!)
- 2. Check the square if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
- 3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
- 4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Determine the approximate position of the motif on the fabric. Hoop the fabric in the embroidery hoop and perform the appliqués. For the lettering, cover the surface with water-soluble stabiliser and wash it out afterwards. Alternatively, use pieces on pattern sheet as a template.
- 2. Cut the fabric with allowance. Hem the side edges. Cut back the allowances in the corners. Sew approx. 15 cm of tape on the allowance in the upper centre and hem the upper and the lower edges.

SUPPLIES

- 0.8 m waffle pique, 140 cm wide
- Appliqué fabrics in red and white
- Remnant of hanger tape
- Thick and thin water-soluble stabiliser
- Jumbo Hoop or embroidery software to reduce the size of the motifs
- Free embroidery file
