

Kimono blouse "Kiara"

Model 7410

Sizes 36 - 48



PRINT THE CUT

1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!)
2. Check the square – if it is 10x10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
3. Put all pages together as shown in the overview and attach them to the boundary lines row by row. Then glue the rows together.
4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size (the overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet). **Important:** Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated.

SUPPLIES

- 2.3–2.9 m rayon fabric, 140 cm wide
- Fabric lining G 700 or G 710 (Vlieseline)
- 2.6–2.7 m bias tape

Optional BERNINA accessories

- [Lap seam foot 70](#)
- [Binder attachment for pre-folded bias tape 87](#) and [Bias Binder foot 95](#)

Cutting

- 2 × front
- 2 × front facing
- 1 × back on the fold
- 1 × rear facing on the fold
- 2 × sleeve

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Iron the Vlieseline on the facings and let cool off thoroughly. Close the shoulder seams right side on right side. Close the side and sleeve seams with a felled seam. Refer to the How-to video concerning the Lap seam foot 70 at bernina.com.
2. Sew the sleeves in and hem them.
3. Close the shoulder seams of the facings. Attach the Binder attachment and foot 95 and bind the outer edges of the facings with the bias tape.
4. Sew the facings along the front and back neckline edges and turn. Finish the facing in the hem. Iron the edges of the hem and the facings, topstitch them and hem the coat. Fix the facings on the shoulder seams



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
