These designs are part of the collection In the Hoop Mug Rugs #12547 which features half of them using a paper-pieced technique and the other half appliqué. Create a matching set using the same fabrics or mix and match using what you have on hand.

L Design is larger than 5" (127 mm) in either direction.

S Design is smaller than 1.5" (38.1 mm) in either direction.

Listings below indicate color sample, stitching order and suggested thread color number. Most numbers indicate Isacord thread. Colors beginning with 20501 refer to YLI Fine Metallics, 7 refer to Yenmet Metallic, 8 refer to YLI Variations Variegated Thread and 9 refer to Isacord Multicolor Variegated.

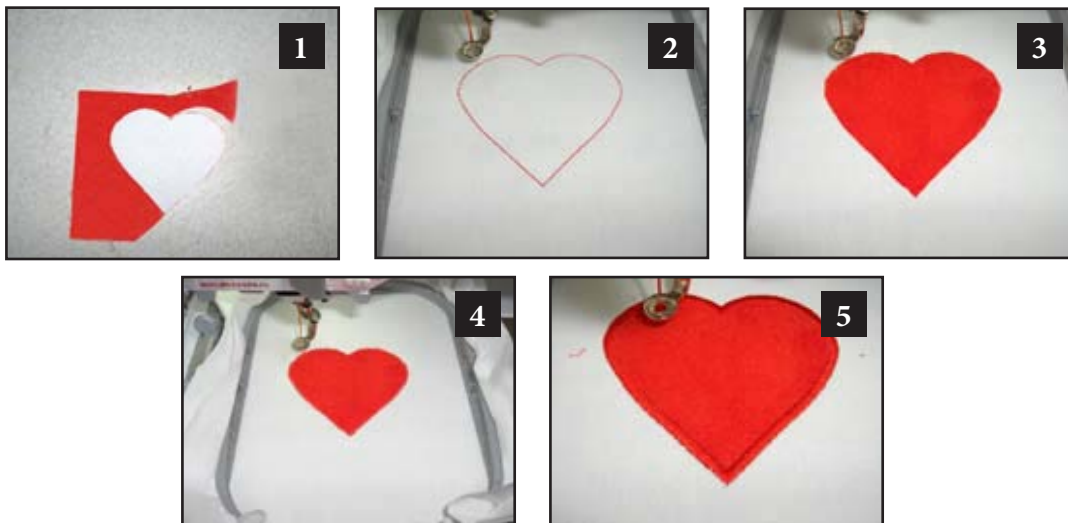
12547-04 Yellow Bird Mug Rug Appliqué

1. Batting Placement Stitch.....	0020
2. Bottom Background Placement Stitch.....	3840
3. Bottom Background Tackdown.....	3840
4. Top Background Placement Stitch.....	3840
5. Top Background Tackdown.....	0922
6. Leaves.....	6051
7. Bird Placement Stitch.....	3840
8. Bird Tackdown.....	0600
9. Orange Bird & Background Linework.....	0700
10. Seam Stitch.....	0020

1. Print out the necessary pages from the PDF of the appliqué pattern(s).
2. Mark the right side of the pattern pieces so you'll know which direction to lay the pattern on the fabric.
3. Lightly spray the wrong side of the pattern pieces with temporary adhesive spray and allow it to set for a few minutes.
4. Place the pattern pieces on the right side of the fabric and carefully cut them out. **PHOTO 1**
5. Sew the placement stitch on your hooped fabric. **PHOTO 2**
6. With the paper still stuck to the right side of the appliqué fabric, spray the wrong side of the fabric with temporary spray adhesive.
7. Place the fabric inside the sewing placement stitch so that it matches the stitching line, and then remove the paper pattern. **PHOTO 3**
8. Sew the tackdown. **PHOTO 4**
9. Sew the remainder of the design and repeat for any remaining pieces. **PHOTO 5**

NOTE: The patterns are sized for the designs as they were made. If you resize the design, you will need to resize the pattern the same amount. You can print out the pattern at the normal size then copy it on a copy machine at the changed size. For example, resize the designs to 80%, resize the printed pattern to 80%.

TIP: When Printing the patterns, make sure that the "Fit to page" option is **UNCHECKED** in the Print Dialog Box. If this option is checked the printed patterns will not be actual size.



Supplies

- Medium weight tear away stabilizer
- OESD Appliqué Fuse and Fix
- Embroidery thread
- Temporary spray adhesive
- Embroidery machine
- Fabrics for each mug rug: (refer to diagram for each paper pieced mug rug numbered sections)



- **12547-01 Sun Mug Rug -**
 - ¼ yd. rays (#1, 5 & 9) and backing fabric
 - 8" x 8" rays (#2, 4 & 7)
 - 8" x 8" rays (#3, 6 & 8)
 - 4" x 4" sun (#10)
 - 5 ½" x 8" cotton batting
- **12547-04 Yellow Bird Mug Rug -**
 - 5 ½" x 5 ½" bottom background fabric
 - 3" x 5 ½" top background fabric
 - 5" x 5" piece bird appliqué
 - 5 ½" x 18" backing fabric
 - 5 ½" x 8" cotton batting

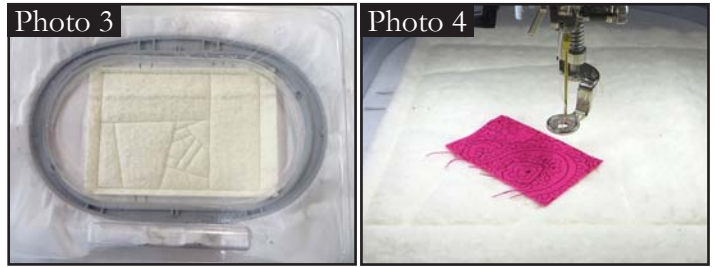
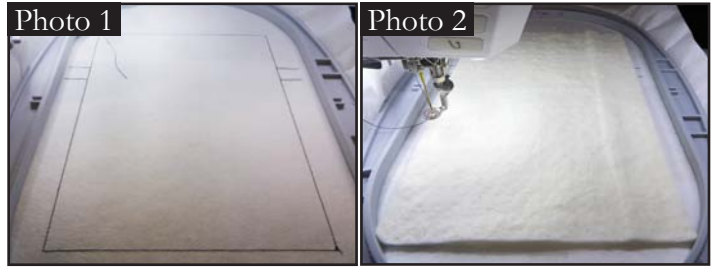
Cut

- For Paper Pieced Mug Rugs – Following diagrams for each mug rug, cut out pieces of fabric for each numbered sections. Cut them slightly larger than each section allowing for ¼" seam on all sides.
- For Appliqué Mug Rugs – Following manufacturer's directions, use OESD Fuse and Fix on the wrong side of the appliqué fabrics. Cut out appliqués using the appliqué template provided.
- For the back pieces of the Mug Rugs – cut a 5 ½" x 11" piece and 5 ½" x 5 ½" piece from backing fabric. Wrong sides together, fold each in half and press.

NOTE: To hold the pieces together better and to create a more stable backing, press a piece of OESD Fuse and Fix between the wrong sides, and then peel off the paper backing and stick together.

Paper Pieced Mug Rugs (12547-01, 12547-02 & 12547-03) Instructions

- Hoop one layer medium weight tear away stabilizer.
- Stitch first color called Batting Placement Stitch.
NOTE: Use a pencil to extend the two sets of parallel lines to make them more clear later. **PHOTO 1**
- Place cotton batting piece over the Batting Placement Stitch. **PHOTO 2**
- Stitch next color called Design Placement Guide/
Placement Guide 1.
- Using a protective shield to cover your hoop, spray the
batting with temporary spray adhesive. **PHOTO 3**
- Following the diagram, place fabric right side up over
section 1. **PHOTO 4**
- Stitch the next color called Placement Guide 2.
- Right sides together, place fabric for section 2 over the
Placement Guide 2 extending past the stitching line
 $\frac{1}{4}$ " and on the previous fabric. Stitch the next stitch
which is the Tackdown/Fold Line 2.
NOTE: Trim both fabrics $\frac{1}{4}$ " from Tackdown stitch.
PHOTO 5
- Flip and finger press the second fabric right side up
over the line just stitched, leaving no wrinkles.
- Stitch the next color called Placement Guide 3.
PHOTO 6
- Right sides together, place fabric for section 3 over the
Placement Guide 2 extending past the stitching line
 $\frac{1}{4}$ " and on the previous fabrics. Stitch the next stitch
which is the Tackdown/Fold Line 3.
NOTE: Trim all fabrics $\frac{1}{4}$ " from Tackdown stitch.
PHOTO 7
- Flip and finger press the third fabric right side up over
the line just stitched, leaving no wrinkles. **PHOTO 8**
- Continue stitching the remainder of the design in this
process until the batting is covered with the pieced
design. **PHOTO 9**
- Stitch the linework color(s). **PHOTO 10**
- Follow the Finishing All Mug Rugs Instructions below.



Appliqué Mug Rugs (12547-04, 12547-05, 12547-06) Instructions

- Hoop one layer medium weight tear away stabilizer
- Stitch first color called Batting Placement Stitch.
NOTE: Use a pencil to extend the two sets of parallel lines to make them more
visible later. **PHOTO 1**
- Layer background fabric right side up with cotton batting. Center and place layered
fabric and batting over the Batting Placement Stitch. **PHOTO 11**

NOTE: For the Yellow Bird Mug Rug (12547-04), center and place the cotton batting over the Batting Placement Stitch. Stitch the next stitch called Top Background Placement Stitch. Place the top background fabric right side up over the Top Background Placement Stitch. Stitch the next stitch called Top Background Tackdown. Stitch the next stitch called Bottom Background Placement Stitch. Place the bottom background fabric right side up over the Bottom Background Placement Stitch. Stitch the next stitch called Bottom Background Tackdown.

- Stitch the next color called Background Tackdown.

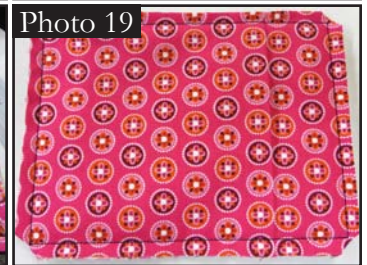

- Follow the basic *pre-cut appliqué instructions*. **PHOTOS 13 & 14**
- Stitch the linework color and remainder of design. **PHOTO 15**
- Follow the Finishing All Mug Rugs Instructions below.



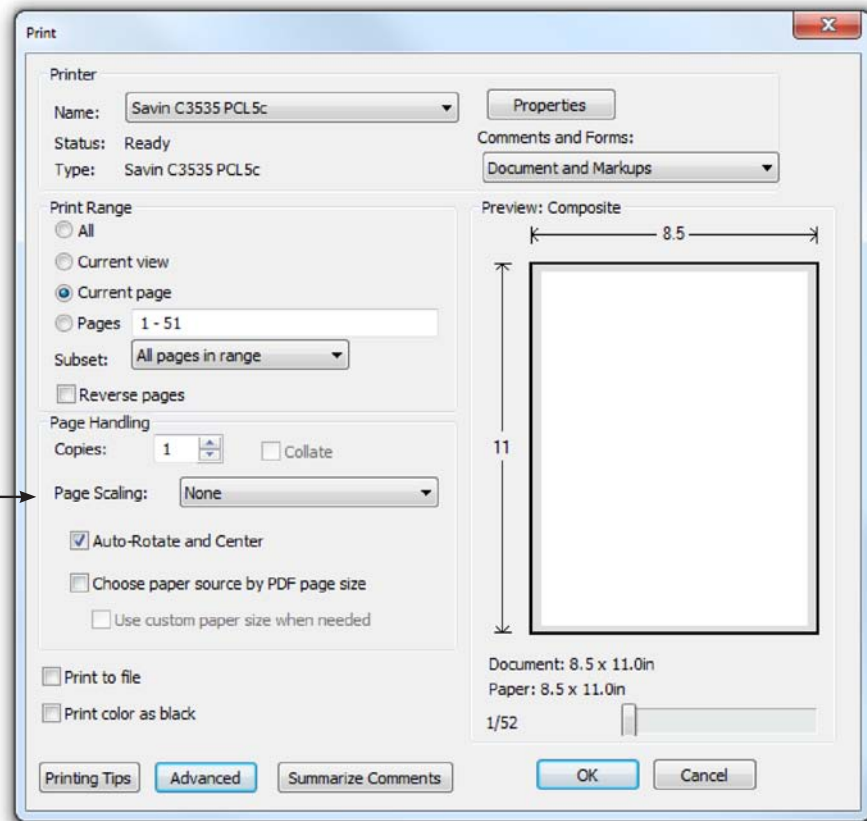
Finishing All Mug Rugs Instructions

- Before the last color change called Seam Stitch, find the two sets of parallel lines that were stitched during the Batting Placement Stitch, and use them as a guide to place your two folded back pieces so that they are overlapping. Place the smaller backing piece on first lining up folded edge with the lower placement line and raw edges even. **PHOTO 16**
- Then place the larger backing piece overlapping with the smaller piece and lining up folded edge with the upper placement line and raw edges even. **PHOTO 17**
- Stitch the last color change called Seam Stitch. **PHOTO 18**
- Trim 1/4" around the seam, and clip corners. **PHOTO 19**
- Turn your mug rug right side out and enjoy!



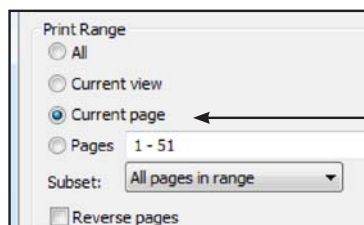
