DESIGNS



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Isacord Thread Colors

0020 Black 2550 Soft Pink 3150 Stainless 4952 Mystic Ocean



- 1-10" x 15" piece OESD Fuse and Fleece (or large enough to fit hoop)
- 1 6" x 10" piece OESD Fuse and Fleece
- 1 6" x 10" piece OESD Fusible Woven CutAway

Fabric/Notions

- 2 6" x 10" pieces of fabric
- 17" ½" wide elastic
- Expert Embroidery Tape Tearaway
- Iron



STEP 1

- Hoop one layer of Fuse and Fleece, fusible (shiny) side up.
- Attach hoop to the machine.




STEP 2

- Fuse the 6" x 10" Fusible Woven to the back of one of the fabric pieces.
 - This is the front of the mask.
- Fuse 6" x 10" Fuse and Fleece to the wrong side of the other 6" x 10" fabric.
 - This is the back of the mask.



STEP 3

• Stitch Color 1, *Placement Stitch*.





STEP 4

- Place the 6" x 10" front fabric right side up, over the placement line.
- Tape in place.




STEP 5

• Stitch Color 2, *Tackdown*.



STEP 6


- Continue stitching design.
- Stitch Left Side Elastic Placement Stitch.





STEP 7

- Place one end of the elastic over the placement line so that the cut edge extends ½" outside of the mask.
- Tape in place.



STEP 8

• Stitch *Left Side Elastic Tackdown*.





Stitch *Right Side Elastic Placement Stitch*.






STEP 10

- Place the other cut end of the elastic over the placement line, so that the cut edge extends ½" outside of the mask.
- Make sure the elastic is not twisted.
- Tape in place.



STEP 11

• Stitch Right Side Elastic Tackdown.



STEP 12


• Tape the excess elastic to the center of the mask.






STEP 13

- Place the back fabric piece, right sides together with the front.
- Tape in place.




<u>STEP</u> 14

• Stitch *Seam,* use a thread color that matches fabric.



STEP 15

- Remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop.
- Trim with an approximate ¼" seam allowance.
- Clip into the seam allowance around the curves.





STEP 16

- Reach into the mask and turn it right side out.
- Press.
- Sew opening shut either by hand or machine.
