- 7535\_Lucky-Pig\_Coin Purse

Always there, the purse is attached to the key ring and thus permanently solves the problem of finding a coin for the shopping trolley.  
The project is embroidered together with the cut and then completed in a few simple steps.



## Fabric / Notions


All materials that do not fray are suitable

- Craft paper metallic ( Swafing ) or
- kulörtexx Style shiny ( korkundkuloer.de )
- Straight-stitch foot with non-stick sole 53
- Press stud

## Designs

### 7535\_Lucky-Pig\_Coin Purse

1. Basting
2. Embroidery
3. Alignment line for ruler
4. Position marking for butthole



## Instructions

Hoop the stabilizer in the hoop. Make sure that the material lies flat on the stabilizer.

Baste the material with colour 1 ( red ).

Colour 2 performs the embroideries as such.

Colour 3 ( blue ) is needed to align the ruler and to cut later.

The last colour (4) defines the position of the buttonholes.

Cut the material according to the blue markings.

At the remaining holes of colour 1, fold both sides up.

Attach the upper part of the presser at the marking below the motif and the lower part below the rounded purse mouth.

Fold the lug so that it is also sewn when sewing the sides. Sew the sides together.

Fold the purse in the centre and close it with the presser.
