
Jolly feathered friends accompany you on your way to work, whether on your tablet PC cover, your mobile-phone case, or your monthly travel-pass wallet.

- 1. Decoration top edges
- 2. Cutting line
- 3. Embroidery (Bird)

Instructions

Mobile-phone case

Size $8.5 \times 13.5 \text{ cm}$ for smartphone $5.7 \times 11.5 \times 1 \text{ cm}$ (adjust size to dimensions of your phone if necessary)

The case has a handy built-in pull tab for quick-and-easy removal of the phone.

Materials

- Faux leather or leather
- Madeira "Cotona" overlocking thread
- Remnant of cotton tape, 1 cm wide
- BERNINA overlocker

Cutting out

Pull-out strap 21x 2 cm. Cut out all pieces without seam allowance.



- 1. Topstitich pull-out strap once all around. Hoop embroidery stabilizer and tack on (faux) leather. Embroider color 1-5. Color 6 is the placement line for the pull-out strap. Tack strap right-side-to-wrong-side below the placement line; the long end protrudes at the right under the hoop. Colour 7 sews on the tape.
- 2. Place cotton tape underneath, parallel to top edge of front section, and sew on at the right and left at a distance of about 2.4cm. Thread through pull-out strap. Fold (faux) leather between front and back sections with wrong sides inwards. Sew front and back sections together within the lines. Fold pull-out strap inwards and cut out cover just within the cutting-out lines. Insert phone; fold over excess length of pull-out strap to the back and stitch down.
- 3. Set overlocker to 2-thread wrapped edge, knife width approx. 2.5. Thread thick overlocking thread through looper; loosen looper thread tension considerably and increase needle thread tension if necessary. Wrap outer edges of cover, sewing the stitches on the curves very slowly stitch-by-stitch with the hand wheel. Unpick thread chain up to top edge of cover; knot threads and push between the layers with a thick needle.

Tablet PC Cover

Size 21.5 x 28 cm

Materials

- 0.3 m "Roxana", 140 cm wide
- Remnant of leather or faux leather in pink
- Madeira "Cotona" overlocking thread
- Zip, 25 cm
- BERNINA overlocker

Cutting out

Cut out all pieces without seam allowance. See pattern last page. Unterlap 27×2.5 in pink.

- 1. Embroider bird in bottom right-hand corner of front section.
- 2. Stitch underlap below the zip tape which faces the front, so that the zip teeth are covered from below. Sew zip below front and back section offset all the way to the right so that the tablet can later be inserted effortlessly, making sure not to catch the underlap on the back.
- 3. Place front and back sections together with wrong sides facing; turn under back ends of zip tape and stitch together edges all around. Set overlocker to 2-thread wrapped edge, knife width approx. 3.5 to 4; greatly increase needle thread tension. Sew cover as for mobile-phone cover.



Instructions

Wallet

Size when opened out 21 x 13.5 cm

Materials

- 0.2 m "Roxana", 140 cm wide
- Leather remnant in grey
- Fabric remnant in pink
- Scrap of clear sheeting
- 1 snaplink (Prym)
- 1 press fastener (Prym)

Embroider first, then cut out!

Cutting out
Faux leather according to pattern (see last page)
2xclear sheeting 9x13.5cm
Closure strip, one 5x2cm, one 3.5x2cm
snaplink strap 13x1cm.
Bias-cut strip 1mx3cm.
Cut out all pieces without seam allowance.



- 1. Print out bird in embroidery software and cut out paper pattern along grey line. Cut out bird in mirror image from leather and appliqué onto the outside with the embroidery file.
- 2. Place inside and outside sections wrong-sides-together, then lay both pieces of clear sheeting on the inside on the right and left. Edgestitch everything together.
- 3. Place closure strip wrong-sides-facing and edgestitch together with one short edge lying flush with the other. Sew the longer outer side of the closure strip right-sides-facing to the left edge of the outside of the wallet. Topstitch snaplink strap all around. Thread on snaplink. Sew loop ends together slightly offset; sew loop right-sides-facing onto top edge at 1 cm off the centre.
- 4. Bias-bind wallet all around and topstitch decoratively. Work in press fastener.
