

Long-sleeve T-shirt "Finja"

Model 322-60

Sizes 36-48



PRINT THE CUT

1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!))
2. Check the square – if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

Important: Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated!

SUPPLIES

- 1.3 m knitted fabric, 150 cm wide
- Embroidery thread "Silver Metallic" (Sulky)
- Embroidery thread "Holoshimmer" (Sulky)
- BERNINA Overlocker L 890
- BERNINA embroidery machine
- Free embroidery file
- Large Oval Embroidery Hoop
- Water-soluble, self-adhesive stabiliser "Solufix" (Vlieseline)

CUTTING

Cut paper piece 3 apart along the diagonal line.

- 1 1 × front part on the fold (to be cut after embroidering)
- 2 1 × back part on the fold
- 3 2 × upper sleeve
- 3 2 × lower sleeve
- 4 2 × frill

Neckline cuff 40.5/41.5/42/42.5/43.5/44/44.5×3 cm, final width 1.5 cm.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Roughly divide the fabric for the front part. Hoop one layer of Solufix in the embroidery hoop, remove the backing paper and stick on the fabric. Stick on another layer of Solufix on top. Fix the layers with the basting function. Embroider the file. Wash out the stabiliser thoroughly.
2. Close the side seams and one shoulder seam. Place the long edges of the neckline cuff wrong side on wrong side on top of each other. Divide the cuff and neckhole into quarters, pin quarter to quarter, and sew the cuff slightly stretched along the neckline. Close the second shoulder seam.
3. Hem the outer edges of the frill with a 2-thread flatlock narrow. Pin a frill each wrong side on right side on the lower sleeve along the dividing seam. Pin the upper sleeve right side on right side above it and sew all the layers together. Iron the allowances upwards. Close the

sleeve seams also including the short frilled edges. Slightly gather the top shaping and sew in the sleeve. Hem the T-shirt and the sleeves with a Coverstitch.
