

Handbag "Monstera"

Model 224-27

Dimensions 24 × 14 cm



PRINT THE CUT

1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!))
2. Check the square – if it is 10 × 10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)
Important: Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated!

SUPPLIES

- 0.3 m suede imitation leather
- Remnant of silver-coloured imitation leather
- Zip, 25 cm
- Filmoplast or firm embroidery stabiliser spray adhesive
- "Super universal" needle (non-stick coating)
- Metallic thread
- CutWork Tool
- BERNINA embroidery machine

CUTTING

- 1 1 × back side
- 2 1 × bottom on the fold

Lid: 2 strips 25 × 1.3 cm. 2 handles: 32 × 4 cm, final width 2 cm.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Hoop the Filmoplast into the hoop with the paper side facing upwards and peel off the backing paper.
Tip: If you don't like the wrong side of the bag fabric, you can embellish it with fabric colour beforehand. Stick on a piece of suede leather in the size of the bag. First embroider the markings and an outer bag outline (basting stitch, slightly larger than the pattern piece). This is followed by the outline of the leaves with the metallic yarn and the cutting process. Do not remove the leaves after cutting, if necessary fix them on the back with a little filmoplast. Place the silver-coloured imitation leather underneath, reduce the machine speed considerably and finish embroidering carefully. Remove adhesive residue from the needle and the CutWork Tool and clean the hook area.
2. Cut out the front 5 mm outside the outer outline of the bag (this results in an allowance of 1 cm in total). Fold in the allowances on one long side of the lid and sew in the zip to create a finished lid width of 4 cm plus allowances. Close the narrow sides of the lid and the bottom to form a ring.
3. Fold in the long seam of the handles and topstitch them. Sew the handles right side on right side to the front and back sides.

4. Sew the bottom/lid ring right side on right side on the front side according to the markings. Open the zip and sew in the back side. Turn the bag inside out. Sew a lining if desired and sew it on the zip tape by hand.
