

Dressing gown

Model 322-50

Sizes S-XL (corresponds to 36-48)



PRINT THE CUT

1. Open the pattern PDF and set the control square to Page 1 with the setting "Original size" on DIN Print A4 paper (US-Letter). (Do not click on "Adjustment to page size"!))
2. Check the square – if it is 10×10 cm, print out the whole cut sheet.
3. Place all pages next to each other as indicated by the arrows and adhere them row by row along the boundary lines, then glue the rows together.
4. Compare the body measurements with the table measurements and cut out the cut parts in the appropriate size. (The overview of the cut parts is on the pattern sheet.)

Important: Instructions do not include seam allowances, unless otherwise indicated!

SUPPLIES

- 2.3–2.6 m waffle piqué, 150 cm wide
- BERNINA embroidery machine
- Lightweight, water-soluble, and tear-away stabiliser

CUTTING

- 1 2× front part
- 2 4× front part facing
- 3 1× back part on the fold
- 4 2× back part facing
- 5 2× sleeve

2 pockets: width 16–18 cm, height 24–26 cm.

Belt: approx. 180 up to 210×10 cm, final width 5 cm. 2 belt loops: 11×3 cm, final width 1 cm.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Downsize the embroidery motif gained from www.embroideryonline.com if necessary. For size 36, we have downsized it to a width of 30 cm and matched the colours with our accessories. For embroidering, place the water-soluble stabiliser on the fabric and embroider the back part. Embroider the pocket pieces with the free embroidery motif, also covering the fabric with water-soluble stabiliser when embroidering. Wash out the stabilisers.
2. Fold in the upper edges of the pockets twice 5 cm wide. Topstitch the second fold just at the width of the foot and unfold it again. Fold in the allowances on the sides and the lower edge. Finished pocket measures approx. 16×17 cm wide up to 18×19 cm high. Sew on the pockets.
3. Close the shoulder seams of the front and the back parts. Cut off the allowances at the sleeve hems. Fold in the sleeve hems twice 5 cm wide. Topstitch the second fold just at the width of the foot and unfold it again. Sew in the sleeves.



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INSTRUCTIONS

4. Sew the belt loops, place the ends on top of each other, and pin them to the side seams. Close the sleeve and the side seams in one go, levelling the sleeve seam in the hem area. Hem the coat.
5. Close the shoulder seams of the facings. Sew the outer edges of the facings right side on right side on top of each other. Place the allowances towards the inner facing and topstitch them there. Sew the outer facing right side on right side on the dressing gown. Sew and finish the lower edges of the facings. Fold in the loose long edge and sew it from the right on the outer facing.
6. Sew the belt cuts together, if necessary. Place the belt lengthwise right side on right side on top of each other and sew both ends, leaving an opening. Turn the belt inside out, topstitch it all around and insert it into the loops.



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
