



Snap Pouches



Create a small handy snap pouch in the hoop of your embroidery machine for carrying lipstick, lip balm, USB stick, etc. Add a key ring and lobster clasp for ease of attaching to your keys. Make several as gifts. They are simple and easy «in the hoop».

Supplies

- Medium tear away stabilizer
- 1/8 yd. fabric (large or small pouch)
- (1") piece ribbon or trim (ring tab)
- Metal key ring
- Snap fasteners
- Isacord embroidery threads
- Temporary spray adhesive
- Optional: Lobster clasp

Cut

Large Pouch


- (1) 3 1/2" x 15" piece fabric (fold in half to measure 3 1/2" x 7 1/2") (Panel)
- (1) 3 1/2" x 7 1/2" piece fabric (Back Panel)
- (1) 3 1/2" x 7" piece fabric (fold in half to measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2") (Top Panel)
- (1) 3 1/2" x 10" piece fabric (fold in half to measure 3 1/2" x 5") (Bottom Panel)

Small Pouch

- (1) 2 1/2" x 15" piece fabric (fold in half to measure 2 1/2" x 7 1/2") (Panel)
- (1) 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" piece fabric (Back Panel)
- (1) 2 1/2" x 6" piece fabric (fold in half to measure 2 1/2" x 3") (Top Panel)
- (1) 2 1/2" x 9" piece fabric (fold in half to measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2") (Bottom Panel)

Instructions

- Hoop tear away stabilizer.
- Stitch the first stitch of the embroidery design which is the Panel Placement Stitch.

- Fold the fabric with the right side up and position it in the center of the placement. Stitch the second stitch of the embroidery design called Panel Tackdown. PHOTO 2



- Stitch the next color called Panel Motif. PHOTO 3



- Stitch the next color called Ribbon Placement Stitch (it is stitched in black for visual purposes). PHOTO 4



- Fold ribbon in half with raw edges even. Center and place raw edges on the top of the Ribbon Placement Stitch. PHOTO 5



- Stitch the next color called Ribbon Tackdown. PHOTO 6

- Take the hoop off the embroidery machine and spray the back of the hoop with temporary spray adhesive. Place the piece of fabric with the right side up on the back of the hoop and sew on the fabric along the front side. PHOTO 7

- Fold the larger piece of fabric and place it along the alignment line. Don't sew yet. Place the smaller piece of fabric above the first one, along the lower alignment line. Sew now. PHOTO 8

- Stitch the last stitch called Seam Stitch. This will stitch the sections together. PHOTO 9

- Remove the pouch from the hoop and trim excess stabilizer and fabric 1/4" from seam stitch. PHOTO 10

- Turn right side out. Press. PHOTO 11
 - Following manufacturer's directions, add snap to the top flap and bottom panel.
- Note:** Place the item(s) in the pouch and mark the placement for the snaps. This is so there is plenty of room for the items with the pouch snapped.

- Add the metal key ring to the ribbon loop. Optional: Add the lobster clasp to the metal key ring for ease of putting on keychain or belt loop. PHOTO 12
- Insert lipstick, lip balm, USB stick or multiple things in your handy in the Hoop Snap Pouch. Enjoy!
