

PUMPED UP POUCH With Embroidery




Materials List

- BERNINA/bernette Embroidery and Sewing Machine
- 30cm of Main Fabric
- 30cm of Lining Fabric
- 30cm of Heavy Tearaway
- 20cm of Iron on Pellon or Heavy Iron on Interfacing
- 20cm Zip
- Embroidery Thread
- Sewing Thread




Method


- Firstly we need to create the students name. There are a few different ways you can do this. The simplest method is to use the alphabets built into the machine.



- Once you have selected your font, type in the name. Select the tick and the design will be ready to stitch.
- To create something different you can use the BERNINA V8 software. Open the software and right click on the Lettering menu.




- Type your name and drop down the menu to chose your font. There are over 99 fonts to choose from, plus the true type fonts as well.




- Click OK and click in the hoop to make the name appear. You can make the design bigger or smaller by clicking and dragging the black handles.



- You can add Elastic Lettering effects to create interest.



- To create individual coloured letters you can break apart the design, and use the colour film at the bottom to change the colour.



- When happy, save the design and then send it to the USB stick using the write to machine option.



- Hoop up your main fabric and tearaway then stitch out your design.



- Use the pattern to cut out your embroidery, other main piece, lining and pellon/ interfacing.



- Iron the pellon/interfacing onto the back of your two main pieces.
- If you have time, you can also embellish the back with decorative stitches.
- Lay one of your main piece right side up. Place your zip, right side down along the top edge.



- Lay one of your lining pieces right sides down on top of the zip. Pin into to place.



- Place a zipper foot on your machine and move the needle to the left. Place your work under the foot with the zip to the left. Line the raw edge up with the right edge of the zipper foot.



- Stitch down the zip. You may need to stop halfway to open/close the zip so you can get nice and close.
- Stitch in the other side of the zip using the same method.

- Press the zip, main pieces and lining. Topstitch the zip using the zipper foot.



- Pull the bag through the opening in the lining. Topstitch the gap closed.



- Open your zip. Flip your pieces so you have the two main pieces rights sides together and the lining right sides together. Stitch around the bottom and sides, leaving a gap in the bottom of the lining. Use your standard foot and a 1cm seam allowance.



- Box the corners, lining up the seam. Stitch into place using a 1cm seam allowance.
