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
STEP FOUR: BUILDING CHAINS 4 - 8

The photo below shows how the various strips and background squares fit together for Chains 4 - 8. It is a useful strategy to place your quilt pieces onto a design wall or on the floor.

1. We'll begin in the top left hand corner with Chain 4. It is identical in layout and construction to Chain 2.



- 2. Chains 5, 6 and 7 are identical. Refer to the photograph above. Note that they are constructed in such a way that only the side strips are attached to the central background square. The top and bottom strips will 'float' unattached at this point as they did in Chains 2 and 3.
- 3. Chain 8 is identical to Chain 3, with a complete chain being formed.



4. Construct the individual units as described and shown above.
