

# In The Hoop Key Ring



## Materials List

- *Good Quality wool felt, cork or vinyl*
- *Sticky tear away stabilizer*
- *Embroidery thread and Bobbin fill*
- *Cut tool and single needle cut plate*
- *Design loaded onto a USB stick*

Stitch out Embroidery.

Carefully remove embroidery hoop and place on a flat surface.

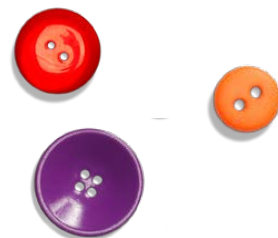
Remove the thread, needle and bobbin from the machine. Insert the cutwork tool with the blade position on #1. change the embroidery foot from JX to JL and select the JL in the pressure foot menu

## Method

Hoop up some sticky stabilizer and remove enough of the paper to hold down the felt "you can also use normal stabilizer with a good quality spray adhesive or use the basting stitch built into the machine

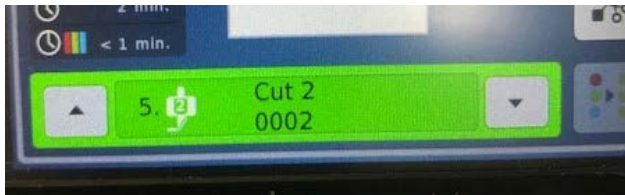


Set your machine up for embroidery with the single needle plate attached and load design. The first part of the design will be the stitch out using bobbin fill on the bottom and the colours of your choice on the top.





Carefully replace the hoop and start the first cut. You will notice thread details now show the different setting numbers for the blade.



Change the blade direction when prompted by turning the plastic wheel to the desired number.



When you have finished all on screen steps, remove hoop and push the keyring out.



Remove any excess tear away and carefully glue the two star shapes together with either a quick dry glue or a hot glue gun, leave the band free from glue. To finish Feed a key ring around the belt.
