

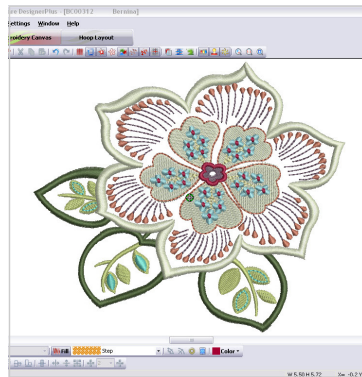

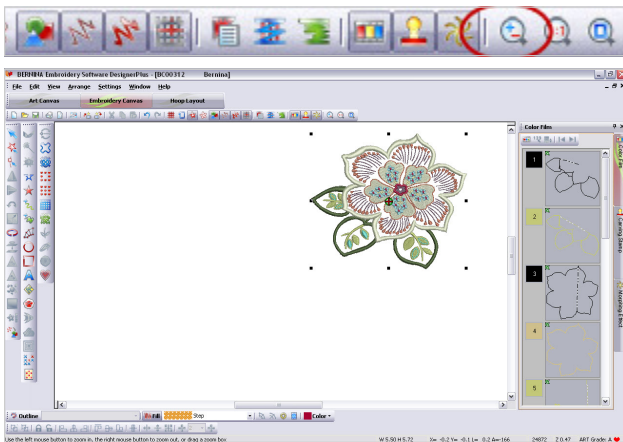

Create the Wreath

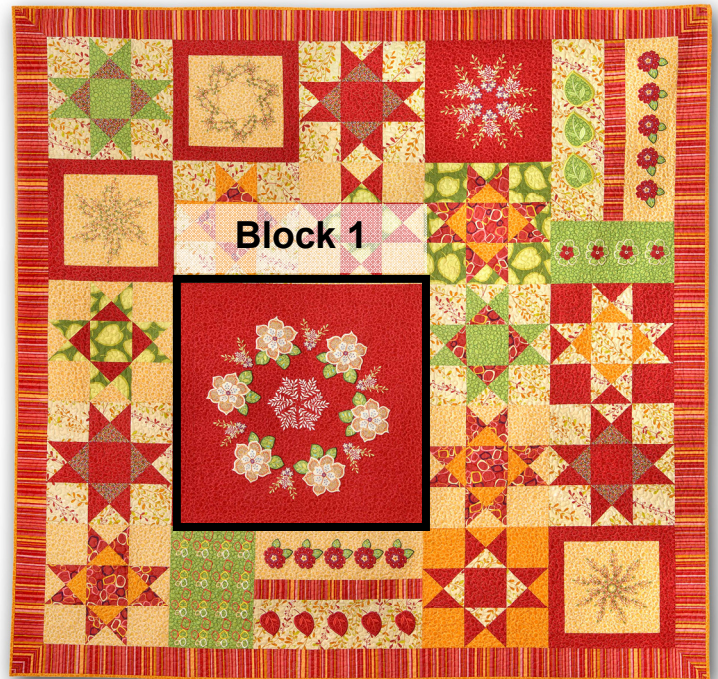
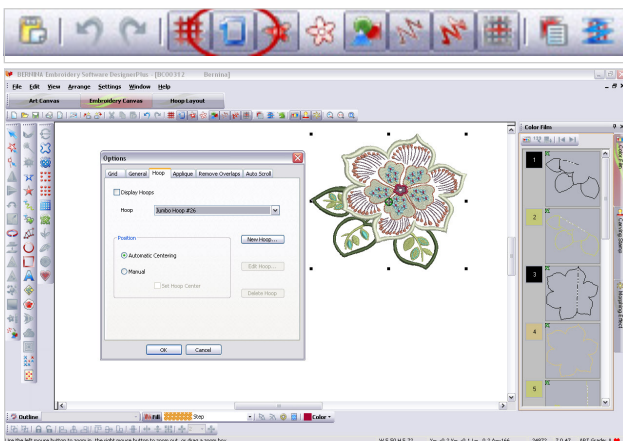
- Open BERNINA Embroidery Software and open design #BC00312 from the Modern Mix collection.



- Select the Zoom Tool and right click on the screen to zoom out, then press the ESC key.



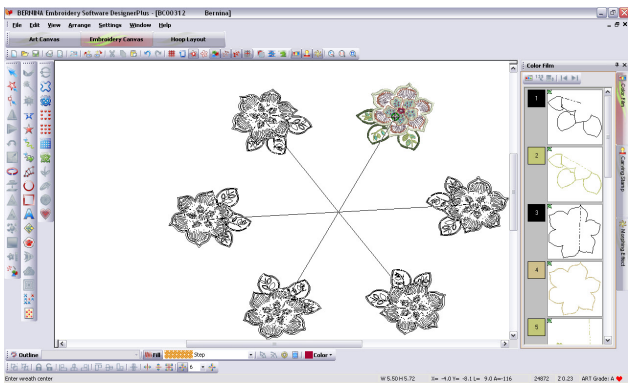
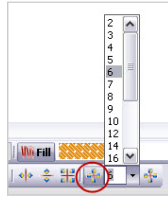
- Right Click on the Select Hoop icon. Choose Jumbo Hoop #26 if you will be embroidering on the BERNINA 830, or the Large Oval Hoop for any other BERNINA machine.



Finished size: 24" x 24"

Note: The hoop does not have to show on screen but later it will be important for the software to know what hoop you are using.

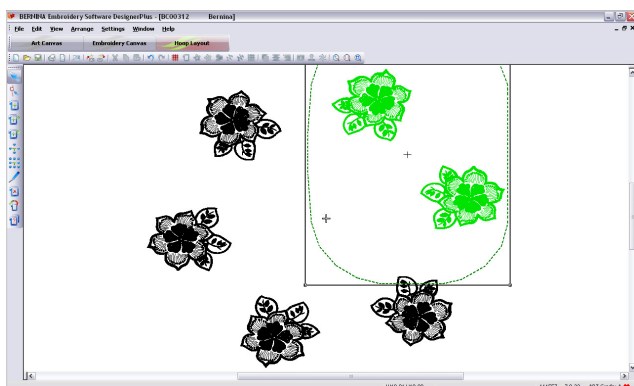
- ◆ Choose the Wreath Tool and select 6 wreath points.
- ◆ Play with the positioning of the flowers until the arrangement is pleasing and looks similar to the illustration below, then left click on the screen.



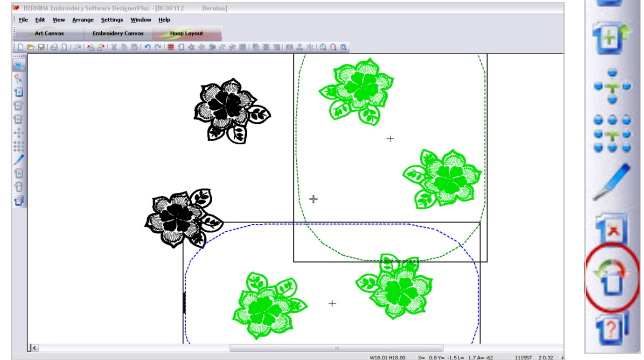
- ◆ The design should be 18" x 18". Save As "wreath."
- ◆ Because this design is too large even for the jumbo hoop, select Hoop Layout.



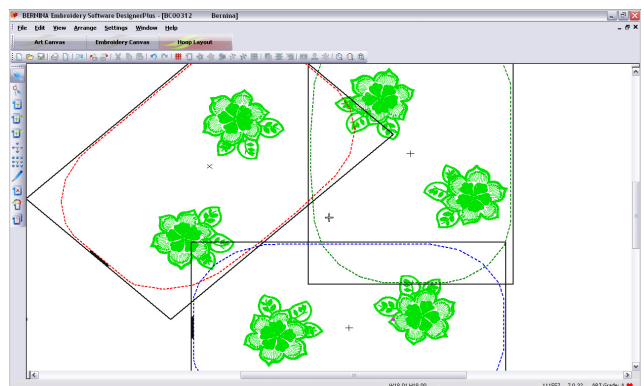
- ◆ For the BERNINA 830, move the hoop to cover two flowers on the right side of the wreath. These flowers should turn green.



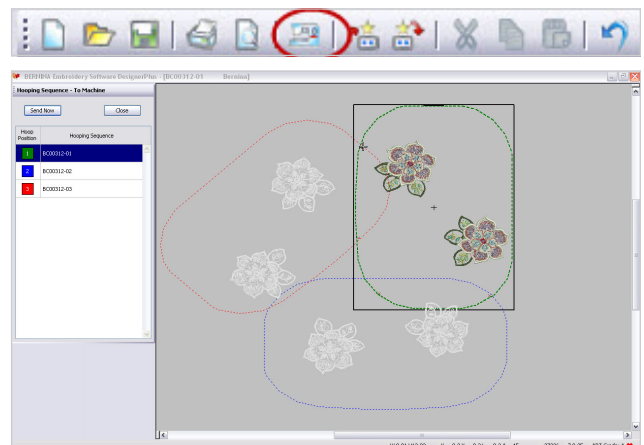
- ◆ Select Add Hoop and then Rotate Hoop twice to rotate 90° degrees.
- ◆ Move the hoop to cover the two flowers at the bottom of the wreath.



- ◆ Select Add Hoop again and rotate this hoop 45°. Cover the 2 flowers in the upper left corner.

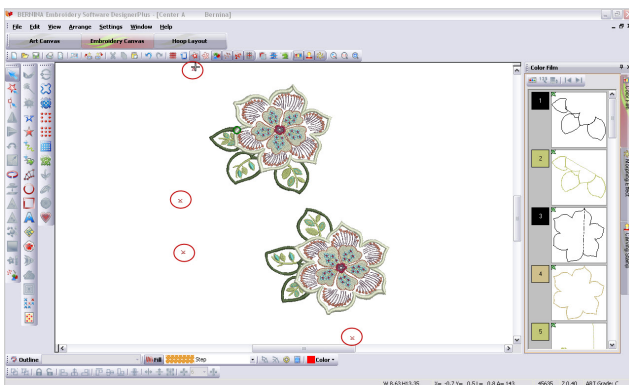


- ◆ When you have two flowers in each hoop select Write to Machine. This will spit the design and show you the individual hoopings.



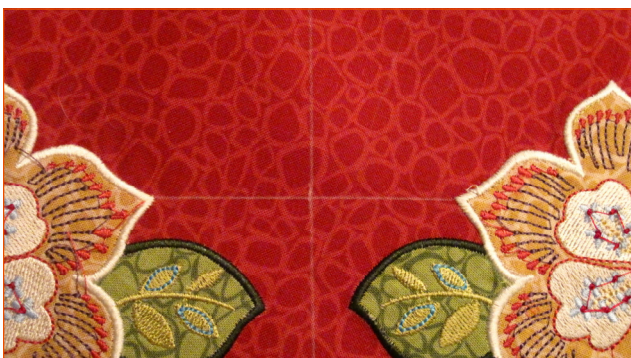
- ◆ There should be two complete flowers in each hoop. Send each hooping (3) to the machine or USB stick of your choice.

- ◆ With other BERNINA machines you will be working with the Large Oval Hoop, and will have six hoopings. Send all six hoopings to the USB stick or machine of your choice.
- ◆ At this point it may be helpful to print templates of the design so you will have a better idea of placement on your fabric.
- ◆ Regardless of the hoop size the software will add registrations marks so you will be able to rehoop for correct placement.



Embroider the Wreath

- ◆ Cut the fabric for Block 1 to 26" x 26".
- ◆ Hoop the fabric with OESD PolyMesh Stabilizer.
- ◆ Embroider the design in the center of Block 1.
- ◆ When the basic block has been embroidered, draw a line from leaf tip to leaf tip. Find and mark the center of this line.
- ◆ Set aside.

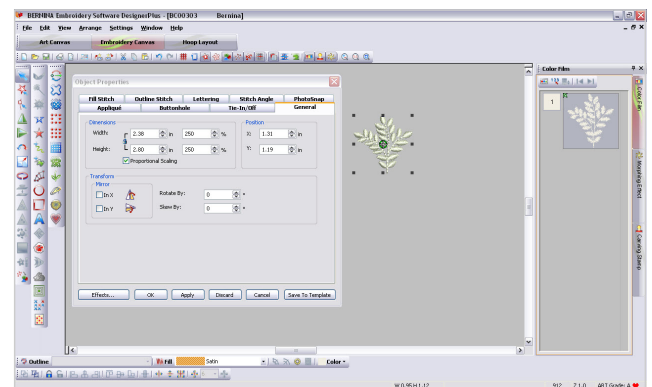


Create the Wreath Center

- ◆ Open design # BC00303.

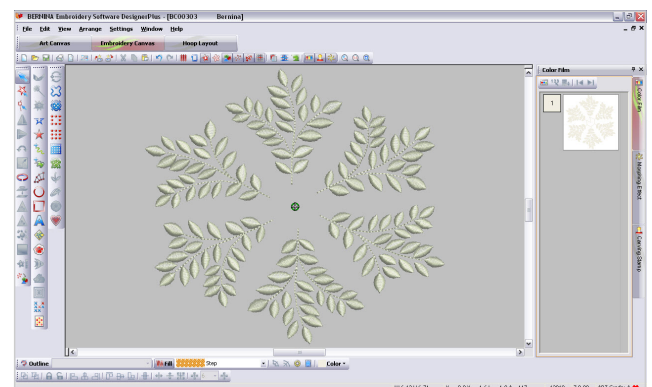


- ◆ Select Object Properties.
- ◆ From the General Tab select proportional



scaling and enlarge the design 250%. Choose Apply, then select Okay.

- ◆ Select the Wreath Tool and choose 6 wreath



points. Arrange the motifs to form the design shown in the illustration.

- ◆ Save As "wreath center."

- ◆ Select Write to Machine and send the design to the machine of your choice.

Embroider the Wreath Center

- ◆ Hoop the stitched wreath.
- ◆ Embroider the center motif.

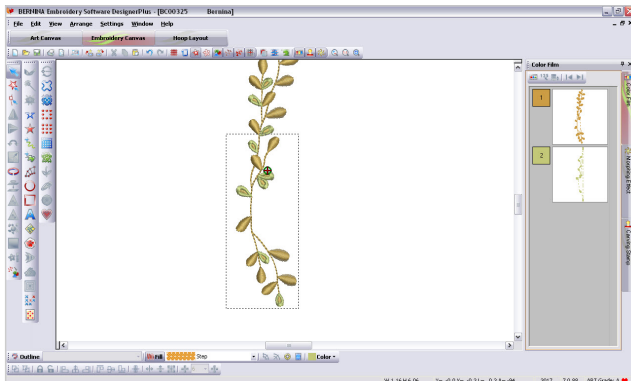
- ♦ Set aside.

Create the Wreath Insets

- ♦ Open design #BC00325.

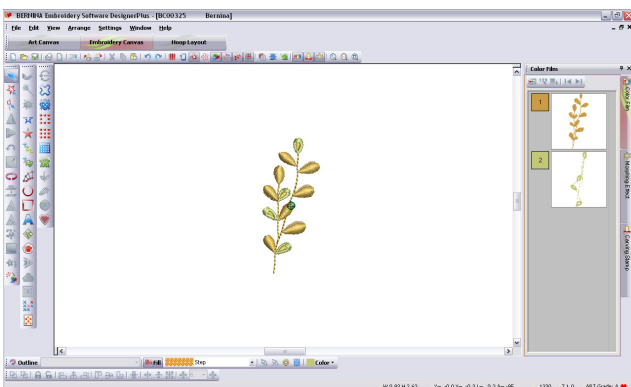


- ♦ Select the design and Ungroup it.
- ♦ Draw a box around the lower portion of the



design and delete it.

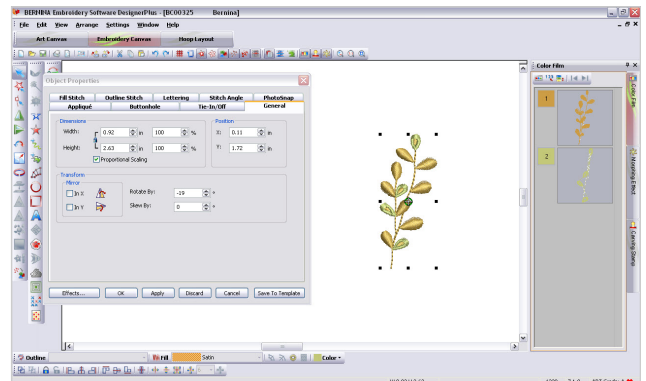
- ♦ Select any remaining parts and delete them.
The design should look like the illustration below.



- ♦ Go to Edit > Select All and Group the remaining pieces of the design.



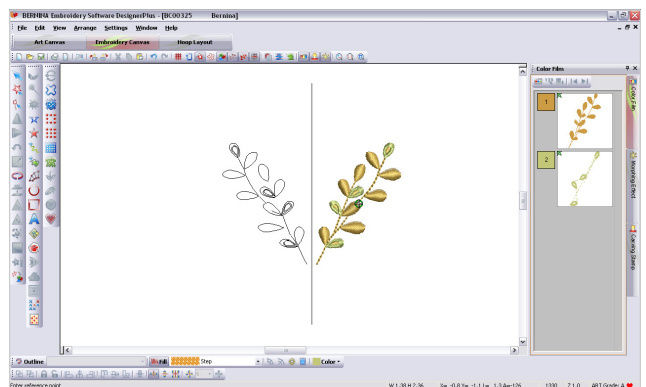
- ♦ Right click on the design to bring up the Object Properties box. Select the General Tab and Rotate the design -18.5°. Select Apply.



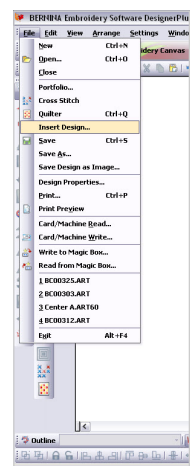
- ♦ With the design selected, click on the Mirror / Merge Horizontal icon.



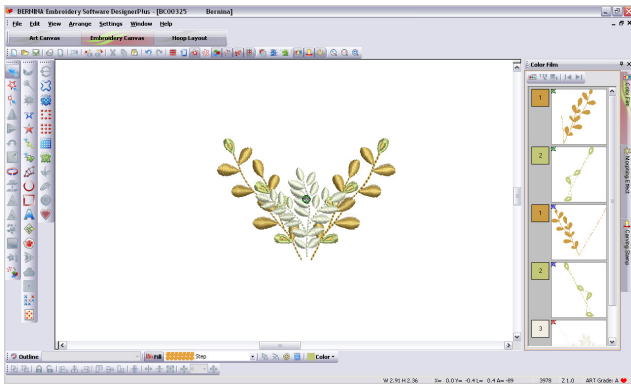
- ♦ Position the mirrored duplicate to the left of the original motif. The approximate total width is 2.80 inches.



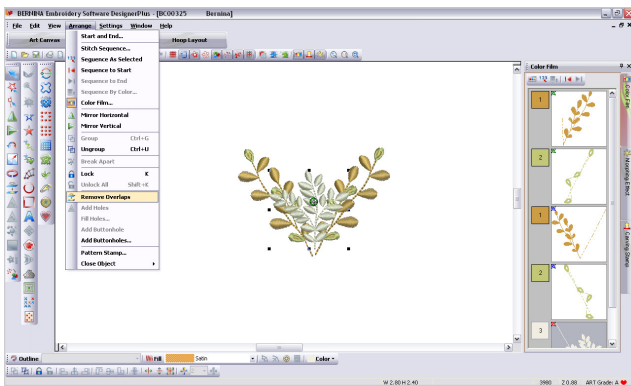
- ♦ Go to File > Insert Design.



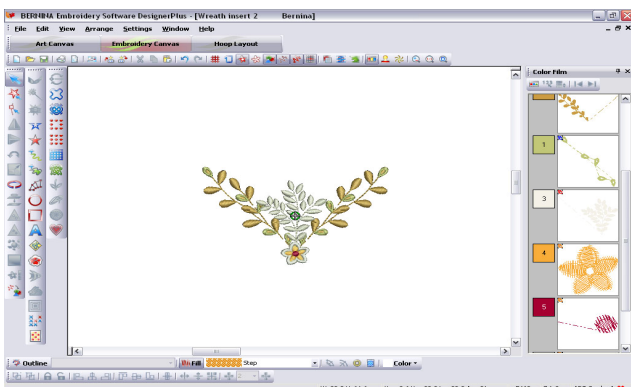
- ◆ Select design #BC00303. Enlarge the design 155% and place it in the lower center of the existing design.



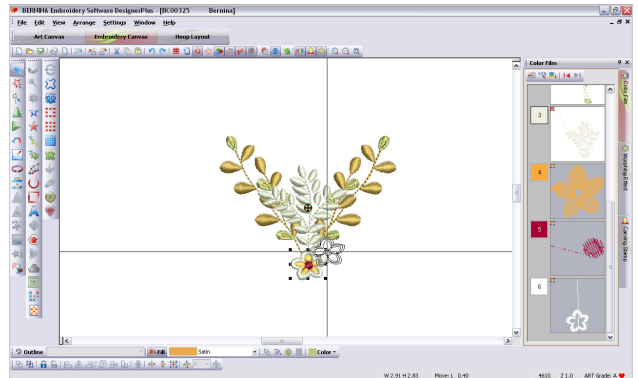
- ◆ With the new design still selected, go to Arrange > Remove Overlaps.



- ◆ Go to File > Insert Design. Select #BC00304. Place the design at the bottom of the existing design.



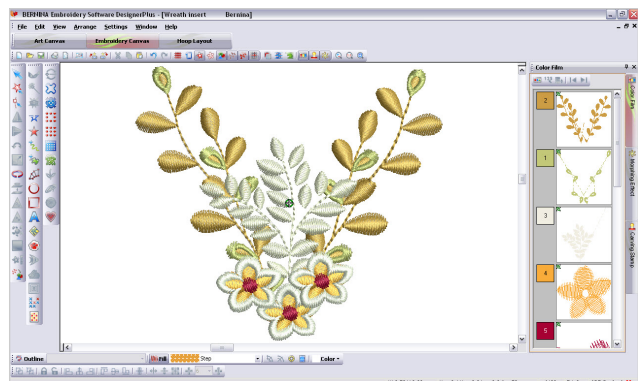
- ◆ Right click and drag on this small flower to create a clone. Place a clone to each side of the original.



- ◆ Select the two side flowers by clicking on one of them, then pressing CTRL on the keyboard and clicking on the second flower.

- ◆ Go to Arrange > Remove overlaps.

- ◆ The design is complete.



- ◆ Save the design as "wreath insert."
- ◆ Select Write to Machine and send the design to the machine of your choice.

Embroider the Wreath Insets

- ◆ Hoop the stitched wreath fabric.
- ◆ Embroider the wreath insets between the flowers in the wreath, centering it on the line previously drawn between the leaves.
- ◆ Square embroidered block to 24½" x 24½"

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
