# Pashmina Shawl Pink Ribbon Awareness

*Pashmina shawls are made of lightweight, soft, beautiful fabrics. These scrumptious shawls are a delight to wear, make wonderful gifts when personalized with embroidery, but can be tricky to embroider. Follow the tips below for successful embroidery on these shawls and other lightweight fabrics.*

*Use OESD Signature Collection #12035 Pink Ribbon Awareness to embroider a shawl for someone special.*

### Supplies

- BERNINA Sewing & Embroidery Machine
- BERNINA Large Oval or Jumbo Embroidery Hoop
- 1 cream pashmina shawl
- OESD Signature Collection #12035—  
“Pink Ribbon Awareness”: #NB812 and #NB815
- OESD AquaMesh Water-Soluble Stabilizer
- OESD Badgemaster Wash-Away Stabilizer
- OESD AquaFilm Water-Soluble Topping
- 505 Temporary Adhesive Spray
- Isacord Embroidery Thread
- OESD Bobbin Thread
- Organ Sharp Embroidery needles
- Water-soluble marker or pen
- The Perfect Placement Kit



### Prepare the Pashmina

- Print templates for designs #NB812 and #NB815, and one for #NB815 mirror-imaged left to right.



- Position the templates at one end of the shawl in a pleasing arrangement. Mark the centers of the designs.

*Note: If you are using a BERNINA 830 and Jumbo Hoop, all of the designs will fit in one hooping.*

### Embroider the Pashmina

- Hoop one layer of AquaMesh Stabilizer with one layer of Badgemaster Stabilizer.
- Lightly spray the hooped stabilizers with 505 Temporary Adhesive Spray. Match the center mark of the design with the center of the hoop.
- Cover the pashmina with a piece of OESD AquaFilm Topping. This will ensure that the stitches sit on top of the fabric rather than sinking down into the fabric.



- ◆ Embroider the design on the pashmina, remembering to mirror-image the second heart design.
- ◆ Repeat for the other end of the pashmina.
- ◆ When stitching is complete, remove the hoop from the embroidery machine and the pashmina from the hoop.
- ◆ Carefully remove the AquaFilm from the front of the pashmina supporting the stitches with one hand while you gently tear away the excess stabilizer with the other hand.
- ◆ With scissors, carefully trim away the excess AquaMesh and Badgemaster from the outside of the design on the back of the pashmina.
- ◆ To remove the excess water-soluble stabilizer, launder the pashmina in warm (not hot) water with a little detergent.
- ◆ Hand the pashmina to dry.



*This pashima uses the same technique, but with designs #NB812 and #NB825.*



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
