The Bold & Beautiful embroidery designs and fabric collection are the perfect combination for creating a tote to carry all your picnic needs for dining al fresco.



Supplies

Machine & Accessories

- BERNINA Sewing & Embroidery Machine
- Large Oval Hoop
- BERNINA CutWork Accessory (optional)
- BERNINA Embroidery Software 6 (optional)
- Edgestitch Foot #10/10C/10D
- Teardrop Embroidery Foot #26
- Patchwork Foot with Guide #57/57D
- 28 mm Bias Binder #88 with Foot #95

Embroidery Collection

- BERNINA Exclusive Embroidery Collection - Bold & Beautiful #80001

Fabric & Notions

- Kwik Sew pattern #3612 (downloadable)
- Benartex Bold & Beautiful Fabric Collection—refer to pattern for yardage requirements
- 505 Temporary Spray Adhesive
- OESD Ultra Clean & Tear Stabilizer
- OESD Applique Fuse & Fix
- Bosal Weft fusible interfacing
- Isacord embroidery thread
- OESD Bobbin Thread
- Organ Embroidery needles, size 80/12 Sharp


Cutting Instructions

- Follow all cutting instructions on the pattern with these exceptions:
 - ◊ Cut a total of 4 side panels (2 will become the side pockets).
 - ◊ Cut the straps 2" wide.
- Cut straight grain or bias strips to equal four times the length of one strap plus twice the width of the side panel. For the 28 mm Binder Attachment #88 cut the strips a scant 1½" wide. Seam short ends of strips together as needed.

Applique the Front Panel

- Arrange Bold & Beautiful designs in BERNINA Embroidery Software or your machine's editing screen as desired for the front panel. Designs used for this tote: 80001-02, 13, 31, 44, and 46.



- Repeat for remaining applique shapes.



- Adhere Appliqué Fuse & Fix to the wrong side of the fabrics for the appliqué pieces.
- Cut out the appliqué shapes:
 - ◊ If you have BERNINA CutWork Software, use the CutWork files provided with the collection to cut the shapes.
 - ◊ If you do not have BERNINA CutWork Software, print and use the templates provided in the collection to cut the appliqué shapes.
- Spray one side of the Ultra Clean & Tear stabilizer with 505 Temporary Adhesive and adhere it to the wrong side of the front panel fabric. Hoop the two layers as one.
- Bring the appliqué design onto the screen and stitch the placement line.
- Remove the Appliqué Fuse & Fix paper backing from one of the shapes. Carefully position the appliqué piece over the placement lines and it smooth into place.
- Complete stitching the design.



Construct the Tote

Straps

- Attach Bias Binder #88 and Foot #95/95C to your sewing machine.
- Fold the strap fabric pieces in half lengthwise with wrong sides together.
- Bind both long edges of each strap.



Miscellaneous

- Use Patchwork Foot with Guide #57/57D to sew the side panels to the front and back center panels using a 1/4"-wide seam allowance.
- Follow the pattern instructions to finish the tote, using Edgestitch Foot #10/10C/10D to aid in top-stitching seams and edges.



Pockets

- Fold the two extra side panel pieces in half cross-wise with wrong sides together.
- Bind the top edge of each pocket.
