Convert Vectors to Embroidery

Open a New File/Blank File

- Click on the New icon or select *File > New*.
- Select *Art Canvas mode*.
- Select *Load Picture*.
- Make sure *All File Formats* is chosen for the *Files of Type*.
- Navigate to the saved logo file included with this lesson, RC Printing Logo Color. ai. Select this file.
- Click on *Import*.
- Press *Enter* to center image on the page.
- Right click and drag the image away from the original and select *Copy Here*.
- While the image is selected, click on *Convert Vectors to Embroidery*.
- The image is processed and the mode switches automatically to *Embroidery Canvas*.
- Return to *Art Canvas*.
- Select the original image by clicking and drawing a bounding box around the group of letters to select all of the parts.
- Click on *Convert Text to Embroidery*.
- Select *Edit> Select All*.
- Open *Object Properties*; click on the *Effects* button at the bottom of the dialog box.
- Select the *Others* tab and change the Pull Compensation to .4 mm.
- Click *OK*.
- Navigate to desired location to save the file and name the file *Converting Vector to Embroidery*.
- Click on *Save*.



Notes:



Use the *Vector Lettering* icon to draw vector lettering in *Art Canvas* and then convert the lettering in one of two ways.

Using the *Convert Text to Embroidery* icon will convert the drawn text to a font and the font can be edited as lettering in *Embroidery Canvas*. This icon is only available in *DesignerPlus* software.

Using *Convert Vectors to Embroidery* will convert the drawn lettering to an object and is not recognized as lettering in *Embroidery Canvas*. This is the only option in *EditorPlus*.
