Use the BERNINA CutWork Tool to create your own Tangram puzzle shapes! Create several sets to use for party games or to give as gifts.

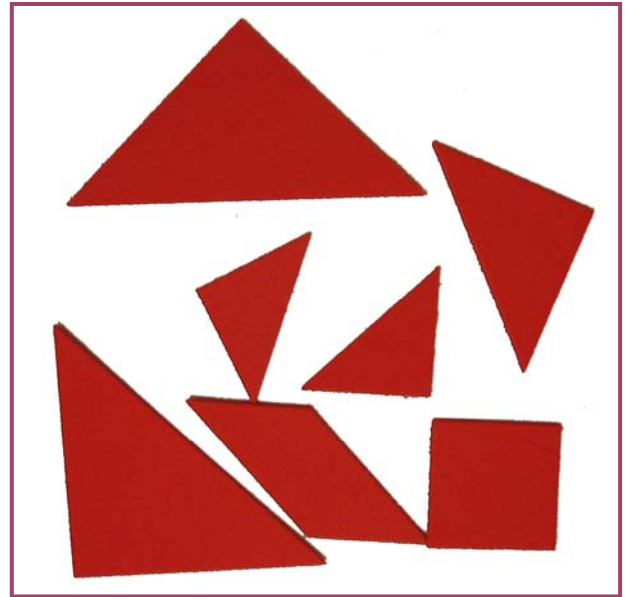
Supplies

Machine & Accessories

- BERNINA Sewing & Embroidery Machine
- BERNINA CutWork Accessory & Tangram.DRAW

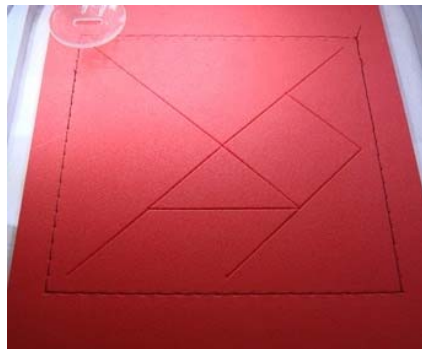
Notions

- 5½" x 8½" sheet of 2mm Craft Foam
- OESD Ultra Clean & Tear



Cutting Out the Tangram

- Hoop the pre-cut (5½" x 8½") pieces of 2mm Craft Foam, with one layer of Ultra Clean & Tear.
- Lay one foam piece on the hooped stabilizer and embroider Color 1 to baste the foam in the hoop.
- Place the Cutwork Tool in the machine and complete the cutting.
- Continue to cut around the outside of the square to release the Tangram pieces.



The **Tangram** is a dissection puzzle consisting of seven flat shapes (tans) that are put together to form other shapes. The object of the puzzle is to form a specific shape given only an outline/silhouette using all seven pieces not overlapping. Originally invented in China, it was introduced to Europe during the 19th Century, and today is the most popular dissection puzzle in the world.
