


Interlooping to form stitches (Rotary hook system)



Instructions

- 1. When the needle moves upwards, the upper thread 1 forms a loop that can then be caught by the hook tip **2**.
- 2. The hook tip catches the loop,
- 3. and pulls the upper thread down, placing it around the lower thread **3**.
- 4. The upper thread now lies around the lower thread. The thread take-up lever tightens the loop 4 and the hook rotates until the hook tip reaches the same position as shown in picture 1.
