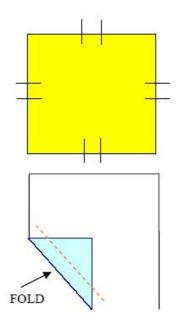

Draw String Bag





Requirements

- 2 x pieces of cotton fabric, 1 plain, 1 patterned. Cut each fabric piece to measure a 25 cm square
- 2 x 70cm of narrow ribbon, braid or cord
- Matching sewing thread
- # 10 foot (edge stitch foot)
- **1.** With right sides of the fabric together and a 1cm seam allowance, stitch around the square, leaving an 8cm gap at one side.
- 2. Turn through to the right sides, clip the corners and press.
- **3.** Attach the # **10 Foot** and move your needle position to the far left.
- 4. Stitch around all 4 sides of the square (*perfect top stitching*).
- **5**. Taking each corner in turn, measure 8cm in each direction from each corner and mark with a pin (8 pins in all) (1st diagram).
- **6.** Fold over each corner using the pin positions as a guide and press (2nd diagram).
- 7. About 1 cm from the folded edge stitch a line across each corner (- - -).
- 8. Thread one ribbon through the channels starting at one side.
- **9.** Thread the second ribbon through from the opposite side.
- **10.** Knot the free ends of each ribbon together.
- **11.** With folded corners to the outside, fill the bag with sweets, soap, pot-pouri or tissue wrapped jewellery.
- **12.** Pull the ribbons tight to close.
