



Quilt Layout with Efflorescence Designs and Juicy Fruits Fabrics




Construction

The blocks are pieced with the Patchwork Foot with Guide #57/57D or Patchwork Foot #97/97D and then embroidered.

This will give an example of how to make sure the design will fit into the finished block. *Measure the blocks are to be embroidered.* This sample block measures 2½" x 6".



- In the software open 82010-25 > while it is selected, rotate right 2x's.
- Insert design 82010-26 > rotate left 2x's > scale down 2x's > place in position just touching the other design. Select both designs > Group.
- From the Digitize Toolbox > Select the Rectangle Tool > Single Outline > create a rectangle > Select it > change the width to 6" and the height to 2½".
- Select the grouped design > Scale down 2x's or adjust size with handles.
- CTRL A > Arrange > Align Centers. Check for fit.
- Delete the rectangle and save as: Block 5a.
- Print a template. Use the printed templates to make sure the embroidery will fit inside the block and that you are pleased with the layout.
- Embroider the blocks using Ultra Clean & Tear Stabilizer.
- Press blocks from the wrong side on a plush towel. Follow the piecing diagram from the Wonky Blox instructions.
- Quilt as Desired.



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
