Use the BERNINA CutWork Accessory to cut out your appliqué pieces and choose from hundreds of stitches to apply the appliqué to the quilt of your choice.

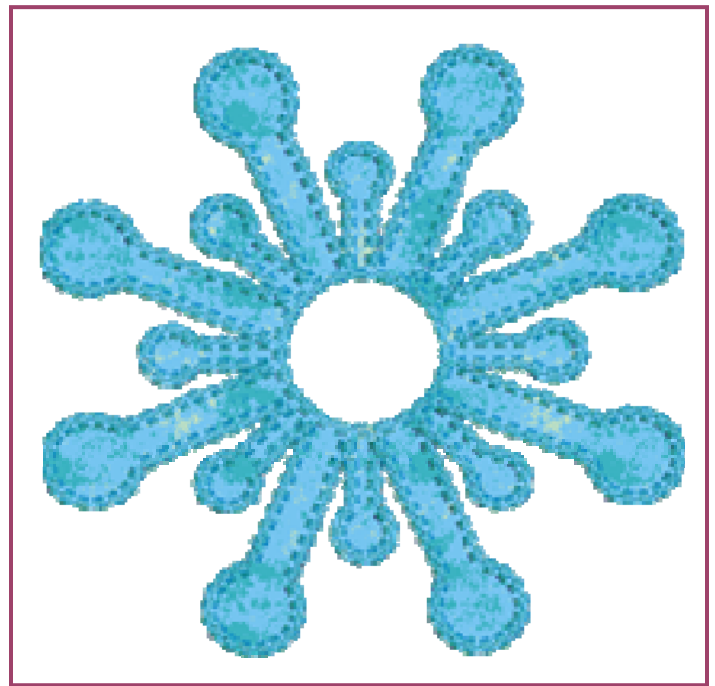
## Supplies

### Machine & Accessories

- BERNINA Sewing & Embroidery Machine
- BERNINA CutWork Accessory & Software
- Flake 1. DRAW file

### Notions

- Fabric for Appliqué
- Fuse and Fix Stabilizer
- HydroStick Stabilizer
- Embroidery Thread & Bobbinfill

## Cut the Appliqué

- ◆ Iron Appliqué Fuse & Fix Stabilizer to back of each piece of fabric to be appliquéd.
- ◆ Secure the appliqué fabric in the hoop with one layer of HydroStick (do not wet the stabilizer) or use Heavyweight Cutaway Stabilizer for best cutting results.
- ◆ Stitch the Running stitch to help secure the appliqué pieces to the stabilizer.
- ◆ Turn the blade as indicated on the screen of the machine.

## Embroider the Appliqué

- ◆ After the shapes are cut, hoop the finished quilt and stitch the first color of the design (a placement stitch).
- NOTE: No additional stabilizer is needed to stitch the appliqué onto the quilt.*
- ◆ Peel the paper backing off the pre-cut appliqué piece, and place it into the outline shape.
  - ◆ Stitch the next color - this is the appliqué cover stitching.
