### Supplies

- Cork Fabric: 1/4 yard
- Cotton Fabric 1: Jumbo or Maxi Hoop: 1/2 yard Midi Hoop: 1/3 yard
- Cotton Fabric 2: Jumbo or Maxi Hoop: 1/2 hard Midi Hoop: 1/4 yard
- Fabric for Applique(s)
- OESD Polymesh Cutaway Stabilizer

- Fusible Interfacing, such as Pellon Shape-Flex
- Fusible Webbing
- Pickle Pie Designs Purse Hardware Set: Jumbo or Maxi Hoop: 1" set Midi Hoop: 1/2" set
- Zipper
- Thread
- Microtex Needle, size 80/12
- Wonder Clips (optional)

### Notes

- All sizes listed are width x length.
- The cork fabric is used on the front of the bag for both style, and for structure. Fabrics C and D will cover some of the cork fabric, so if you choose cotton fabrics that are lighter than your cork fabric, you should press fusible interfacing to the wrong sides of those fabrics to prevent the cork from showing through them.
- You can use a zipper that is longer than the given sizes and cut off the excess. Zipper must have plastic teeth.
- WST = Wrong Sides Together.



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### **Other Fabric Prep**

- Press Fusible Webbing to the wrong side of the Applique Fabric(s).
- Press Fusible Interfacing to the wrong side of Fabric G.
- Optional: Press Fusible Interfacing to the wrong sides of Fabrics C and D.




### **STEP 1**

• Lay one strap piece on a table, right side up. Place the second strap piece over the first piece, right side down, as shown, leaving a 1/4" overlap on each edge.



#### STEP 2

Mark a line on the fabric, from one corner to the other.






• Pin to secure.





#### **STEP 4**

• On your sewing machine, stitch along the marked line.



#### STEP 5

• Remove the pins and trim to a 1/4" seam allowance.





• Unfold and press the seam open.





### **STEP 7**

• Fold the strap in half, lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press.



#### STEP 8

• Open the fold and place the interfacing for the strap against the inner fold. Press to fuse.





• Fold the bottom edge up to the center and press.





### STEP 10

• Fold the top half down to the center and press.



#### STEP 11

 Fold the top down once more. Press, then pin or use Wonder Clips to secure.





• Topstitch along the length of the strap, first on the closed side, then repeat along the open side.





### STEP 13

• Slide the strap through one clasp.



#### **STEP 14**

• Fold the strap in 1/2" - 1", then fold again. Pin or clip to hold in place.





• Stitch across the strap to close. Repeat on opposite end to complete the strap. Set aside.





### STEP 16


• Repeat steps with 12" Hardware Strap Piece, then cut into two, 6" pieces. Set aside.






### **STEP 1**

 Using thread to match your cork fabric, sew Stitch Sequence 1 directly on your stabilizer to stitch a main project outline and a placement line for your zipper.



#### STEP 2

Remove the hoop from your machine, leaving your project hooped. Center the zipper, right side up, within the placement lines, with the zipper pull at least 1" across the left stitch line. Tape the zipper in place outside the placement lines. Sew Stitch Sequence 2 to tack down the zipper.



#### STEP 3

• Center Fabric A above the zipper. The lower edge of the fabric should sit slightly above the zipper teeth. Tape in place. Sew Stitch Sequence 3 to tack down the fabric.





#### **STEP 4**

• Center Fabric B below the zipper. The top edge of the fabric should sit slightly below the zipper teeth. Tape in place. Sew Stitch Sequence 4 to tack down the fabric.



#### STEP 5

 Change to thread to match Fabric C, and sew Stitch Sequence 5 to create a diagonal placement line for Fabric C.



- Center Fabric C along the top of the diagonal placement line, right side down. Tape in place.
- Sew Stitch Sequence 6 to tack down the fabric.





### **STEP 7**

- Remove the tape and fold Fabric C down over the stitch line so it is now right side up. Finger press the seam and tape in place.
- Sew Stitch Sequence 7 to tack down the fabric and sew the quilting stitches.
- Trim off the excess fabric from the lower angled stitch line, and around the curves where the bird will be stitched, cutting as close to the stitch line as you can, without snipping through the stitches. Do not cut any fabric outside of the main project outline.




#### STEP 8

• Change to thread to match Fabric D. Sew Stitch 8 to create a diagonal placement line for Fabric D.



- Center Fabric D along the top of the diagonal placement line, right side down. Tape in place.
- Sew Stitch Sequence 9 to tack down the fabric.





### STEP 10

- Remove the tape and fold Fabric D down over the stitch line so it is now right side up. Finger press the seam and tape in place.
- Sew Stitch Sequence 10 to tack down the fabric and sew the quilting stitches.
- Trim the excess fabric ONLY on the top right curve of the fabric, and around the curves where the bird will be stitched, cutting as close to the stitch line as you can, without snipping through the stitches. Do not cut any fabric outside of the main project outline.




#### **STEP 11**

 Change to desired thread color. Sew Stitch Sequence 11 to stitch the accent stripe (leaves and stem for flower applique files).



- Change to thread to match Applique Fabric A1.
- Sew Stitch Sequence 12 to stitch a placement line for applique fabric.






### **STEP 13**

- Peel off any paper backing from the applique fabric and center the fabric over the placement line, right side up. Sew Stitch Sequence 13 to stitch a cutting line.
- Remove the hoop from your machine. Trim the fabric along the cutting line, getting as close to the stitches as possible, without snipping them.




#### **STEP 14**

- Replace the hoop on your machine and sew Stitch Sequence 14 to sew the satin stitches on the bird.
- Stitch Squence 15 to sew bird accents.




- Remove the hoop from your machine and turn it over to the back. Carefully trim out the stabilizer that is covering the center of the zipper.
- Center Fabric E above the zipper, wrong side down, with the fold facing the zipper. Align the fold 1/8" above the zipper's horizontal center. Tape in place along the edges and top.
- Center Fabric F below the zipper, wrong side down, with the fold facing the zipper. Align the fold 1/8" below the zipper's horizontal center. Tape in place along the edges and bottom.





### **STEP 16**

• Return the hoop to your machine and sew Stitch Sequence 16 to tack the fabrics in place.



#### **STEP 17**

• Sew Stitch Sequence 17 to create placement lines for the strap.



#### **STEP 18**

 Fold each strap tab in half and insert a D-ring inside. Place the first strap tab over the left placement line. The raw edges should extend over the top of the placement line by 1/2", and the fold should be facing the zipper. Tape in place above the main project outline. Place a piece of tape over the D-ring to hold it in place. Repeat with the second strap tab on the right placement line.






### **STEP 19**

- DON'T MISS THIS STEP! Remove any tape from the zipper. Unzip the zipper 2/3 of the way across the bag.
- Sew Stitch Sequence 18 to tack down the fabric just along the left side.



#### **STEP 20**

 Remove the hoop from your machine and turn it over to the back. Center Fabric H (back lining) over the project, right side down. Tape in place.



#### **STEP 21**

• Replace the hoop on your machine and sew Stitch Sequence 19 to tack down the fabric.





### **STEP 22**

• Remove the hoop from your machine and remove the project from the hoop. Cut away the excess stabilizer. Trim around the project leaving a 1/2" seam allowance. To reduce some bulk in the seam, trim the cork fabric right up to the stitch line.



#### STEP 23

- Turn the bag right side out through the opening in the side, pressing out the corners and seams as you go.
- Turn in the open seam on the side and fuse a piece of seam tape in the seam to close it.
- Turn the bag right side out through the zipper, poking out the corners and seams as you.





• Attach the clasps of the strap to the D-rings on your bag to finish.





 Using thread to match your cork fabric, sew Stitch Sequence 1 directly on your stabilizer to stitch a main project outline and a placement line for your zipper.



#### STEP 2

Remove the hoop from your machine, leaving your project hooped. Center the zipper, right side up, within the placement lines, with the zipper pull at least 1" across the left stitch line. Tape the zipper in place outside the placement lines. Sew Stitch Sequence 2 to tack down the zipper.


• Center Fabric A above the zipper. The lower edge of the fabric should sit slightly above the zipper teeth. Tape in place. Sew Stitch Sequence 3 to tack down the fabric.
